Option Schedule: GPS has implemented a program whereby each Junior High Option class is run in 3 sections. Different teachers with different areas of expertise will teach each section. As a result, the sections offered to Grade 7, 8, and 9 students will vary depending on teacher expertise. Each option will run for 6 weeks. The rotation will begin again at semester change in February.
